



CRAM / CAPTAIN JACK'S MUSKEGON REGATTA

WHEN: August 20-21, 2011

WHERE: Captain Jack's Bar & Grill 1601 Beach St. Muskegon, Mi 49441

VENUE: This is the 6th stop on the CRAM eight regatta schedule. The city of Muskegon and Captain Jack's have been very supportive in having our group hold an event here at the Municipal Park. The regatta site has multiple accommodation options;

Fisherman's landing is an RV park located a short distance down the road on the Lake Muskegon side; there are Hotels and Motels within 5 miles of the beach. Downtown Muskegon is a close trolley car ride from the beach, the trolley runs back and forth from the beach to downtown every hour, this will give the beach crew something to explore during the day. Captain Jack's is right across the street and has great food and refreshments. This site has great potential to expose our sport to many people, the municipal beach is just south of the Catamaran beach and will be host to a multitude of sports from a Beach Volley ball tournament being held the same weekend, Kite boarding and a 5k run that will pass through (**Watch out for runners please**) our area Saturday morning.

ACCOMODATIONS:

The city of Muskegon has approved the use of a parking lot directly across from Captain Jack's Bar and Grill. **The Beach lot has limited space for approximately 12 RVs** and 3 tent sites on pavement; the beach accommodations have no electricity, there is a small bath house across the street with an outdoor shower, change room and restroom. There are also RV/tent sites available at Fisherman's landing RV Park located on Lake Muskegon a short distance from the Regatta site, these sites have *electricity, a full bath house with hot showers and restrooms.*

Reservations: must be made **online via the CRAM.**

HOSPITALIY: Hosted by Captain Jacks.
